

## STUDENTS

### Student Dress Code

The standards of dress for school should conform to the dress codes which are developed cooperatively by students, parents, and school staff. Student dress and overall appearance must meet basic standards of health, safety, cleanliness, and decency. Student dress which is disruptive or reasonably likely to cause disruption to the educational environment or to the rights or well-being of other students or staff is not permitted.

The Associate Superintendent for Student Learning and Accountability (or designee) is responsible for implementing and monitoring this policy.

The Associate Superintendent for Student Learning and Accountability (or designee) is responsible for reviewing this policy in 2010.
